#### Did you know? ...

The first Senior Citizens program was organized in 1963 by the seniors of Emanuel UCC. The name was "Emanuel Senior Citizen's Society". Reverend Kuether was the Pastor of Emanuel.

On January 28, 1970 an amendment was made to include others of the community who are not members of Emanuel UCC.

In November, 1971 the name was changed to "Senior Citizens of Manchester". Anyone 60 years or older could be a member. In later years, the age was dropped to 55 years and older.

Newspaper staff put out the first newsletter in December of 1983. There was a contest to name the paper. Eileen Disbrow won and that is how we got the title "The Trumpeter".

The first Senior Citizen Center was at 214 North Macomb Street, Manchester. An Open House was held on September 22, 1985.
