Turkey Stuffing Recipe

Here is a turkey recipe that also includes the use of popcorn as a stuffing ~ imagine that. When I found this recipe, I thought it was perfect for people like me, who just are not sure how to tell when poultry is thoroughly cooked, but not dried out.

Ingredients:

8-15 lb. turkey

1 cup melted butter

1 cup stuffing (Pepperidge Farm is Good)

1 cup uncooked popcorn (Fancy Farm is the best) Salt & Pepper to taste

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 350°F.

Fill cavity with stuffing and popcorn. Place turkey in baking pan and brush the turkey with melted butter, salt and pepper.

Place prepared turkey in the oven with the neck end toward the front of the oven

Listen for the popping sounds. When the turkey's back end blows the oven door open and the bird flies across the room... It's done! Hope it gave you a good laugh!!
