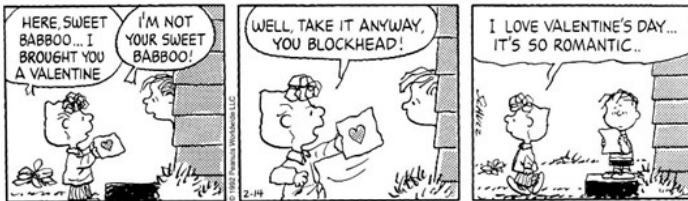

(MANCHESTER, Mich.) On October 1, 2020, The Library Network rolled out a new service for all member library patrons: Automatic renewals. Eligible library materials checked out from the Manchester District Library (MDL) now automatically renew three days prior to the due date, saving patrons time and reducing the occurrence of late fees.

Auto-renewal does not apply if:

- the item has pending holds,
- the item has already reached its renewal limit,
- or the patron has a block on their account that prevents renewals, most frequently due to upcoming card expiration.

If an item cannot be renewed, MDL patrons will receive a due date reminder by their chosen notification method (email, text or phone). Please return items by the due date so that other library patrons can enjoy them and to avoid accruing late fees. Patrons can always check item due dates by logging into their library account at manchesterlibrary.info or by calling (734) 428-8045 Monday-Friday 11am-5pm or Saturday 10am-2pm.

The Library Network (TLN) is a public library cooperative serving 74 libraries in southeast Michigan — including Manchester District Library — through facilitation of shared services, systems, and materials
