MANCHESTER AREA SENIOR CITIZENSCOUNCIL, INC BY-LAWS REVIEW

Page 2 ARTICLE V. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

***Reads: "Section 1. The Board of Directors shall consist of ten (10) persons, fifty-five (55) years of age or older, elected by the general membership."**

Recommended Change: The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than seven (7) or more than ten (10) persons, fifty-five (55) years of age or older, elected by the general membership or by a unanimous vote of the existing board.

***Reads: Section 5. Six Board members shall constitute a quorum.**

Recommended Change: A simple majority of the Board of Directors membership shall constitute a quorum Con't.....
