**The Village of Manchester is continuing to provide free, lead-reducing water filters to Village households** with children or pregnant women who receive WIC benefits, Medicaid insurance, or cannot afford a water filter (filters cost about \$35 and their replacement cartridges cost about \$15). Filters will be available to qualifying households who have not already received a filter at the Village offices. The Village will also have educational materials to hand out with each filter.
