Coupon booklets will be available while supplies last. for both programs. You must be a **Washtenaw County residents AND 60 years of age or older.**

**Senior Market Bucks:** no income requirement. Coupons can be used on Michigan-grown foods, including fruits, vegetables, eggs, cheese, yogurt, meat, poultry, fish and honey. Foods not mentioned in the above list are not eligible. Non-food items cannot be purchased with Senior Market Bucks'.

As in previous years, booklets in the summer contain 10 coupons, each coupon worth \$1.
