As most are aware the Manchester Area Senior Council has been working VERYHARD to provide a "permanent" space for card, lunches, activities and programs. The City Council has given us our own space but we need to raise the funds for required renovations.

### **FUND RAISING PROJECTS**

**~ Projected Cost \$240,000 ~**

HVAC, Kitchen, Handicap bathroom, Exterior handicap access door from the Rear parking lot, Replacing ceiling tiles, Repair/paint walls, Flooring, Back-wall windows, Back-wall door, Storage area.

To date we have received a grant of \$136,280. We need another \$100,00 and are doing fundraisers and applying for additional grants.

We have an opportunity for Patronicity dollar-for-dollar matching grant IF we reach our goal of raising 1/2 of that (\$50,000). There will be NO match if our goal isn't reached.

You can help us reach our goal and FINALLY have our own home to enable us to provide much need, consistent services to our area seniors. We are a 501C3 non-profit organization.
